Leisure/Events

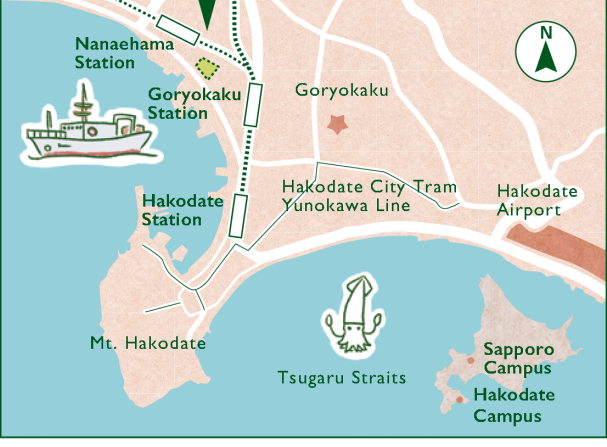

Hokkaido University Sapporo Campus
Hokkaido University (commonly abbreviated as Hokudai) is a national university founded in 1876. While it also has a campus in Hakodate, most of its faculties, graduate schools, and research institutes are located in Sapporo City.

Hokkaido University Hakodate Campus
Located in southern Hokkaido, Hakodate is home to campuses including the Faculty of Fisheries Science, Graduate School of Fisheries Sciences, and School of Fisheries Sciences. Hakodate is a port city blessed with abundant fisheries and marine resources, providing an excellent environment for students and researchers studying fisheries.

The University Botanical Garden
The University Botanical Garden and University Museum operated by Hokkaido University, were established for the purpose of botanical education and research that are also open to the general public.

Nakajima Park
Enjoy events in all seasons throughout the year, including cherry blossom viewing, summer festivals, autumn foliage, and snow candles. The park contains historically significant buildings designated as Important Cultural Properties by the Japanese government, as well as a concert hall.

Odori Park and TV Tower
The TV Tower, one of Sapporo's most iconic landmarks, stands in Odori Park, the venue for the Sapporo Snow Festival

Toyohira River
The riverbank features areas where you can enjoy BBQ and jingsukan-style grilled lamb, and fireworks festivals are held in the summer.
